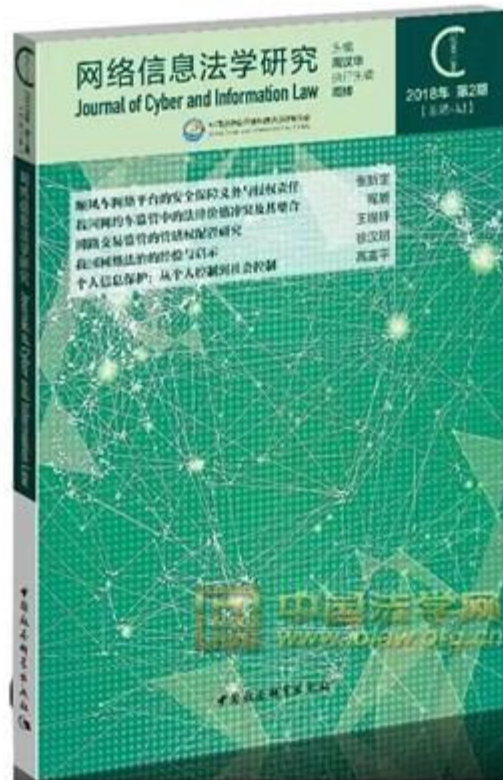


Latest Book: Journal of Cyber and Information Law No. 2 (2018)
