
Latest Book: Studies on Intellectual Property Rights No. 25

Studies on Intellectual Property Rights is one of the earliest book series published by the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences. Since it was created by Professor Zheng Chengsi in 1996, a total of 25 volumes have already been published. Beginning from 2019, two volumes will be published each year. This book series focuses on real life, highlights the legal issues in artistic creation and in the production, dissemination and utilization of information, pursues academic interests, encourages information freedom, and rejects the practice of giving priority in order of seniority. The volume is divided into eight parts - Theme Discussion, Judicial Frontiers, Information Law Studies, Typical Cases, Forum of Graduate Students, Book Review, Foreign Trends of Development, and Scholars' Memoirs - and consists of a total of 15 articles.
