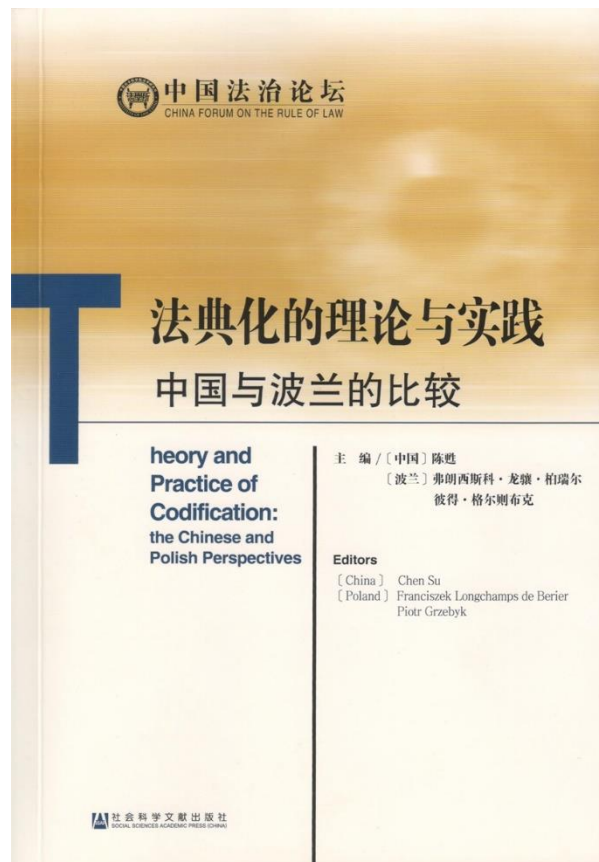


**Latest Book: China Forum on the Rule of Law: Theory and Practice of Codification: the Chinese and Polish Perspectives**
